The Academy is the voice of the social science community in the UK. Full membership of the Academy is only available to individuals who have made a

significant contribution to the social sciences. It is by nomination and is subject to peer review. Similarly, Learned Societies need to be membership associations promoting excellence in at least one of the social science areas.

The Academy has launched an Affiliate Scheme to confer many of the benefits of full membership.

3. Affiliates will also be able to participate in, and contribute to, workshops, conferences and symposia. These events communicate developments in intellectual thought and facilitate debate on the implications for both public policy and corporate development. Highly topical issues have included:
